Our study visits

CODATU organises study visits to cities in the North (in Europe) and in the South, on the theme of sustainable urban mobility for cities and public authorities in charge of urban mobility in the South.

Visits are organised to our members' and partners' sites (operators, manufacturers, public transport authorities, training and research institutions, etc.) to exchange views with experts on a variety of topics defined jointly with the beneficiaries.

Study visits alternate between discussions and field visits on technical and strategic issues:



Experiences in the North

Visits to the North contribute to cooperation between the world's cities and the sharing of good practice drawn from the experience of mature mobility systems.



An Indian delegation in Paris and Amsterdam to study the integration of urban planning and transport, intermodality, the transition to electric vehicles and active modes.

A Tunisian delegation in Lyon and Grenoble to explore active mobility policies and their implementation.

Experiences in the South

Visits to the South enable delegations to discover mobility systems similar to their own and to put their local problems into perspective.



A delegation from Nairobi (NAMATA) in Cape Town to study the planning, governance and operation of a BRT network, and the professionalisation and integration of paratransit.

A delegation from Buenos Aires in Bogota and Medellin to look at the development of public space, intermodality and the urban integration of transport infrastructures.

CODATU is an **international NGO** set up in 1980 in Dakar during the World Conference on Urban Transport. Its mission is to **promote** sustainable urban mobility in the cities of the South.

CODATU offers **cooperation** between cities, **exchanges** of experience (scientific, technical, economic, etc.), **training**, **publications**, **international conferences** and **pilot projects**.
